




The process to support

- Healthcare will have to shift to patient centred community care
 - Keeping patients out of the hospital is the focus
 - Patient empowerment and prevention is key
 - Coordination between GP's, nursing homes, homecare, hospitals, and allied health professionals is imminent
 - Providing access to specialized knowledge becomes the best way to insure high quality care

Framework for Health Information




Some key characteristics

- Pro-active role of the patient
- Coordination of Patient Health and Professional Care
 - Sharing of information: homecare and selfcare
 - Sharing of care pathways: joined-up patient care
 - Patient self service: efficient and effective
- Closed loop quality and financial control
- Secondary use of data
- Tremendous effort in thinking and working differently

Generic Telemedicine System





Integrated Telehealth System





Focus on Guidelines and DSS



History of the Joint Initiative Council

- Charter with ISO, CEN, and HL7 signed August 2007
- Renewed with CDISC and IHTSDO September 2009
- GS1 joined November 2010
- Projects carried through
 - ISO 21090:2011 Harmonized data types for information interchange
 - Individual Case Safety Report (ICSR)
 - IDentification of Medicinal Products (IDMP)
 - Standards Knowledge Management Tool (SKMT)
