
White Paper: One citizen - One record

 - Government issued in 2012 a new regulation that allows for all who treat the same patient in an established community to use a common medical record for the patient

"One citizen - One record"


How can « One citizen – One record» be realized in order to make updated EHR information available for the patient and health workers throughout the process of care?



- Includes both health- and care sector
- Different alternatives/arcihtectures should be considered
- Risk, management challenges and organizational concequences will be evaluated for all alternatives
